Legislative Update

Mr. Holmes provided a legislative update.

SF1 and HB1 which contains the ECA have moved into conference committee where they will work together and hopefully come up with a budget which will serve the best interest of everyone.

HB22, which deals with teacher accountability, is also in conference committee where two amendments are being addressed.

HB183 and SF75, Repeal Gun Free Zones and Preemption Amendments, has been tabled. The district will continue to watch these bills to see if they resurface. If they stay inactive, the district can move forward with collecting public comment regarding armed educators.

February 27 is scheduled as the last day of the legislative session.

Trustee Celebrations

Mrs. Durgin expressed her appreciation to the district for working so hard to implement changes over the last few years.

Dr. Clouston recognized Devon Energy for awarding \$25,000 in grant funding to the district. Wagonwheel Elementary and Conestoga Elementary were awarded Devon Energy grants to purchase additional supplies for their STEM Labs.
