

1330 Community Use of School District Facilities

The Board of Trustees recognizes that District facilities belong to the general public of the School District and that certain facilities are needed to help meet the cultural and recreational needs of the county. However, the Trustees also realize District facilities are primarily for educational programs. The Board is entrusted with the proper use of these facilities and is responsible for the financial investment. District facilities may be used by outside groups as long as such use does not interfere with scheduled or projected District activities.

Facility use is to be of a public nature and available to a majority of the county population for such worthwhile activities as educational, cultural, civic or charitable programs. Activities that interfere with District programs, constitute an extreme public nuisance, teach theory or doctrine subversive to government organizations, represent excessive use by a single organization, or are dances sponsored by organizations other than recognized student activity groups will not be permitted.

Charges for building use may be assessed by building supervisors. Charges are intended primarily to recoup the cost of Campbell County School District employee overtime and supplies and materials used in support of the building use; however, charges may vary based on group type, intended use, stewardship and whether there is an admission charge. Building use charges will be assessed and collected by building supervisors who will ensure school district facilities are used under the conditions provided in Regulation 1330-R.
