Transition Steering  
Committee and  
Subcommittee Reports                      Dr. Brown shared that the Steering Committee continues to watch enrollment closely. Construction at the facility continues to move forward in a timely manner. Dr. Brown also mentioned that the budget subcommittee is working on allocations for the secondary schools in an effort to remain budget neutral.
- Mr. Kelly Hornby shared that the curriculum subcommittee has completed the process of identifying all core sequencing except CTE. The subcommittee's next focus will be on assessments.
- Mr. Kip Farnum updated the board on the activities of the identity subcommittee. Requests were sent to art teachers, students, and community artists asking for submittals for the Thunder Basin High School logo. All entries are due by February 29.
- Mr. Larry Reznicek shared with the board that letters have been sent to secondary certified staff explaining the protocol that will be followed for transfers when opening Thunder Basin High School. A new interest survey has gone out to certified staff now that the principal and attendance area boundaries have been established. An interest survey has also been sent to all secondary ESP staff.
- Mr. Cliff Hill updated the board on the activities subcommittee. Junior high coaches will meet with sixth grade students to let them know about the opportunities at the junior high level. There has been much discussion regarding booster clubs. The booster clubs will remain separated by activity; however, a decision will need to be made as to how to split the funds between the high schools. Conversations have begun as to how many coaches will be needed at each high school.
- Dr. Ayers shared that work is being done to get information out so parents and students have the correct information concerning the school they will be attending.
- Facilities Update                              Dr. Brown provided a facilities update to the board. The Stocktrail Elementary School construction is on schedule. The first FF&E package is expected to be ready for approval at the March 8 board meeting, and the library package is expected for the March 23 board meeting. The CCHS-South Campus foundation on the north side is progressing, and the walls on the south side are almost completed. Design on the play field and track is expected to be completed by April. The weather has helped to keep both projects on schedule, and projects are still in good shape with regards to the contingency budget.
- The Meadowlark HVAC upgrade and kindergarten remodel is currently in the design stage. The maintenance department is gearing up for summer projects.

Legislative Update	Dr. Brown expressed appreciation for Dr. Fall and Mr. Foreman's attendance at the WSBA Legislative Forum. Dr. Brown also reviewed legislative issues with the board. Decisions on education funding will be made by the next board meeting, and administration will be able to provide estimates to the board on how funding changes will affect the district.
