Call to Order

Westwood High School Celebration Principal Kelly Morehead introduced English Teacher Tana Dally and her students. The student performed a rap of Beowulf they wrote and choreographed to the delight of the trustees and audience.

Mrs. Morehead presented an academic report for the school including demographics, graduation rate, MAP scores, interventions. Brief discussion of plans to transition to the new facility followed.

Facilitator Report - Foreign Language

Facilitator Brandee Mau reported about progress of the district-wide PLC, improved of student performance on DSPA's, and this year's goal of motivation. Discussion about adding Chinese to the curriculum followed.

Enrollment Projections

Dr. Strahorn presented the report from Middle Cities Education Association regarding district enrollment projections. In summary, he noted that the district is growing steadily with the potential enrollment of 10,160 students K-12 by 2016-2017, and there are increasing capacity issues at the junior highs which will require attention very soon.

Textbook Adoption

Dr. Brown asked Mr. Fenton and Facilitator Brandon Crosby to present information about the elementary math textbook being recommended, Math in Focus, published by Houghton Mifflin Harcourt. Mr. Crosby reviewed the process by which the recommendation was obtained. Mr. Fenton noted the large amount of donated costs by the publisher with the final cost being \$812,181.54. Mrs. Ochs moved to approve the adoption, Mrs. Shippy seconded, and the motion carried.

Executive Session

Mrs. Shippy made a motion for an executive session to discuss personnel, Mrs. Hepp seconded, and the motion carried at 8:27 p.m. Dr. Fall recessed the meeting and reconvened the regular meeting at 9:30 p.m.
